Walkers Finance

The Secretary of State for Business, Enterprise and Regulatory Reform (BERR) received an appeal from Walkers Finance, of Manston, Leeds, against the determination of the Office of Fair Trading to revoke its standard licence issued under the Consumer Credit Act 1974. A hearing of the appeal took place on 16 – 18 July 2008 before a panel of persons appointed by the Secretary of State to hear the appeal on his behalf. The panel made a report to the Secretary of State. On 30 September 2008, the Secretary of State, having considered the panel's report and accepted its recommendations, dismissed the appeal.
